- 2. The scholarship application must be returned to Mrs. Hunskor in the TGU Granville School office by April 24th, 2014. The completed applications will be given to the Mylo Jones Scholarship Committee for review.
- 3. The scholarship(s) will be presented at the TGU Granville Graduation.

- 4. Student will answer the following questions in typed paragraph form;
 - A. What are your plans for college? Where do you plan to attend and what are you considering majoring in?
 - B. Describe the activities that you have been involved in during your high school years and how those activities will help you in your future. (Please include academic, athletic, clubs, groups and organizations.)
 - C. Describe two of your most memorable moments while attending TGU Granville School. One having to do with academics, the other with athletics or activities that you are involved with.
 - D. What teacher or staff member has influenced you the most in your education and why?
 - E. Which family member has had the most influenced on you during your educational years and how.
