AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT DETERMINATION PROCEDURE

The scholarship(s) will be awarded yearly to deserving individual(s) as recommended by the scholarship committee with the approval of the Post 155 members present. Each scholarship committee member shall review all applications employing the following criteria;

Scholastic Achievement

Personal ambitions and goals

Personal references

Community involvement

Completeness of the application

Each category will be rated on a scale of 1-10 by each committee member. The applicants with the highest scores will be awarded scholarships. The number of scholarships and the monetary value of the scholarships awarded may vary from year to year.

Granville American Legion Post 155 Scholarship Application Procedure

The scholarship(s) are open to all graduating seniors of TGU high school, Granville campus. To be considered the application must be complete and submitted to the Granville High School secretary no later than May first. All application information must be typewritten and include the following items.

Name, address, telephone number and date of birth of the applicant

Grade point average (attach a copy of your high school transcript).

List the name of the school you are planning to attend.

What is your intended field of study?

List any high school extracurricular activities that you have participated in and any academic honors, scholarships or any other recognition you have received.

List any involvement you have had in community activities and or organizations including but not limited to church.

List any family members that are members of the American Legion, Legion Auxiliary or Sons of the American Legion or have family members that have served in the armed forces.

In your own words on no more than one typewritten page describe your understanding of what the American Legion is and does.

In no more than one typewritten page discuss your goals and ambitions.

Include two (2) letters of recommendation, (teachers, pastor, etc.), one Letter **must** be from a teacher the other should be from someone other than a teacher.

A check will be issued to the chosen school of the scholarship recipient when the Adjutant of the Granville American Legion post has been informed that the recipient has registered and is attending the institution of their choice.

Two personal recommendations
One recommendation must be from a teacher. The other should be from someone not related to you, and not a teacher.
Personal ambitions and goals
Using NO MORE THAN ONE single-spaced type written page discuss your career choice and goals.
In your own words, using NO MORE THAN ONE single-spaced type written page, present a brief description of your understanding of the Legion and its function and purpose in the community.
