

Harry Renke Memorial Scholarship

Background Information

Harry Renke was a history and physical education teacher as well as high school principal at Towner Public Schools. He also coached football and track and field for many years during his career. Education and athletics were a large part of his life. Through this scholarship, his family wishes to leave a legacy of remembrance.

Who is Eligible?

High school seniors at Towner-Granville-Upham (TGU) Public Schools.

Award

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded annually in May of each year to an outstanding student and athlete; payable to the college/university for deposit into the student's account the 2nd semester of their freshman year.

How is a Recipient Determined?

A committee comprising the superintendent and/or high school principal, one teacher, and one athletic coach will determine the recipient based on the award criteria and application responses, in conjunction with the Renke family.

Primary Award Criteria

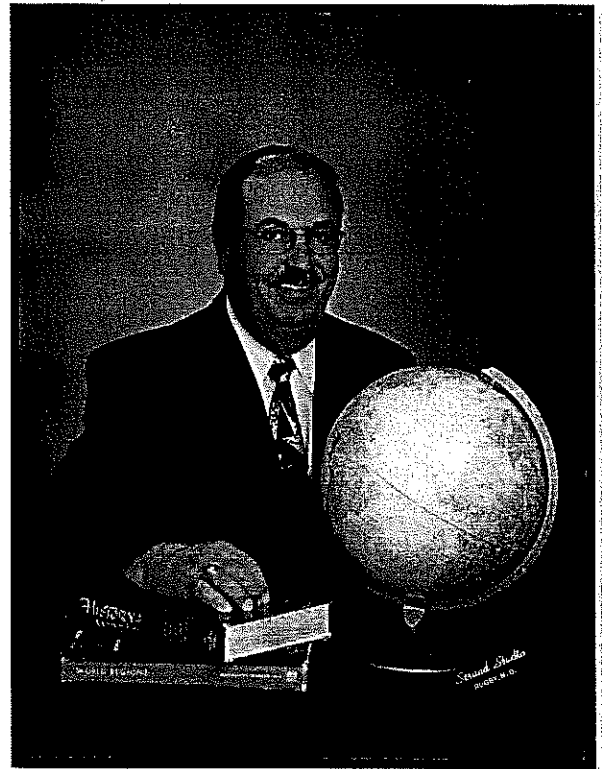
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
